Addendum to PSRA Constitution

Honorary President

Role of Honorary President

- Progression would ordinarily be from Chair to Honorary President, refers "President".
- Appointment as President will be for one year, and will be renewable, on an annual basis, by mutual agreement of the Committee and the incumbent.
- Upon appointment of a new Honorary President, any incumbent's term will cease.
- The election of a President shall be by vote at a PSRA Committee Meeting only, with quorum accepted.
- Committee will provide updates, minutes and invites to Association events whilst the President is in post
- Appointment of an Honorary President is at the discretion of the PSRA Committee. The Committee is not required to appoint an Honorary President.

Duties of a President

- To be a goodwill ambassador.
- Represent the Association favourably, telling people what the Association achieves, and to support recruitment and engagement in the local community.
- Whilst the Vice Chair is a second, the President will support the Association and stand in for the Chair appropriately as identified by mutual agreement with the Committee.
